Tracey Sims – Kingfisher Calling

Tracey has created a brand new project for us for our retreat. This beautiful project encompasses many different techniques, including feather quilting on Osnaberg Linen, satin stitch dimensional embroidery, lime wash painting techniques, metallic thread quilting over paint, silver leaf application, colour wash painting, machine embroidery, appliqué in hoop, the use of inbuilt decorative stitches and Trompe l'oeil effects with paint to create a 3D appearance.

It is completed on raw canvas and can be framed or mounted as a piece of wall art. This is a two day project.

Retreat projects will be suitable for all levels of embroiderer and all brands of machine.

Requirements will be advised as soon as they are available and your deposit is paid.

COST

\$595 per person

Includes tutor fees, accommodation, all main meals, cleaning fees, unlimited tea and coffee, retreat bonuses, gifts and prize draws, optional additional projects and most embroidery designs.

Workshop requirements including embroidery designs for Tracey Sims' workshop are an additional cost.

There is a \$10 fee payable to Tracey Sims at the time of the workshop, to cover the cost of paints, adhesives and gold and silver leaf which will be provided by Tracey.
